First Year of the Three-Year Law Course (LL.B.)

CAP Round – 1

20th August to 22nd August 2026 (Excluding Sundays & Public Holidays)

The admission procedure is as follows -

1. The candidate, who is allotted to ILS Law College, must **personally** attend the admission process. Please find below the schedule.
2. The candidate must bring **all original** documents for scrutiny for the purpose of admission. The College will not admit the candidate if he/she does not have all original documents at the time of admission.
3. The candidate should bring 3 copies of Allotment Letters issued by CET Cell.
4. Candidate should carry Aadhaar Card & PAN Card. (Kindly note that an Aadhaar Card is compulsory; a PAN card if it is available)
5. The College will not admit the candidate if: -
 - a. he / she does not personally attend the process, OR
 - b. he / she does not bring original documents for our scrutiny at the time of admission process, OR
 - c. his / her documents are not complete, OR
 - d. he / she does not pay fees, OR
 - e. he / she does not complete other formalities, OR
 - f. he / she is not eligible under the rules and provisions applicable to admissions.

Admission Process :

1. The candidate must get his / her name registered first.
2. After registration, candidate has to get the documents verified with the college authorities and proceed for online form filling in the College Library.
3. Once the Online Admission Form is filled, student must get his / her eligibility documents verified in College Office.
4. After verification of eligibility, student will get link for payment on his / her registered email address.
5. Except the Principal, no other person is authorised to grant or to promise or to make any representation regarding admissions.
6. All admissions are provisional and subject to further approval/conformation by the Savitribai Phule Pune University, CET Cell and the ARA.
7. Candidate has to prepare the conversion certificate with self-attestation along with the name & signature of the parents (if necessary) as per the CET brochure.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. The candidate is NOT eligible for admission if he/she does not possess a provisional allotment letter.
2. The candidate must bring all original documents, along with the applicable category certificate(s), if any, and one set of colour-scanned copies of all the documents.
3. The candidate must bring a soft copy of his / her recent passport size photo with plain background of size between 20 KB and 200 KB in .png or .jpeg format

(2) If Mark sheets of First year, Second Year & Third Year are separate, then such candidate will have to upload the Mark sheet of all three years along with the conversion certificate in single PDF. 4) LL.B.-3 Year CET-2026 on-line application form. 5) MAH-LL.B.-3 Year 2026 CET Score card. 6) Domicile Certificate Or Birth Certificate mentioning place of Birth Or School Leaving Certificate mentioning Place of Birth. Or Community, Nativity & Date of Birth Certificate.
